☐ Meet with Your Academic Advisor	
For a final evaluation of your requirements, to formulate a plan for graduation, and determine the classes you need to take during your last two semesters. It is a good idea to have your degree audit with you at this time. If you are unsure who your faculty advisor is, check your Student Center in Buckeye Link . ☐ Verify Your Address
<u>Update your Addresses (Local and Permanent)</u> where it says "Change Address" to ensure you receive all pertinent information without delay. Check this address for mail in addition to logging into your OSU e-mail on a regular basis.
☐ Pay Your Financial Obligations
Pay any fees, tickets, fines, etc. before commencement. You will not receive your diploma, may not order transcripts, or have other documents released if you have unresolved financial obligations to the university.
☐ Have all HOLDS Removed
Complete a Financial Aid Exit Interview (if required)
☐ Verify Graduation Deadlines for our College
☐ Visit the OSU Bookstore
Visit the OSU Bookstore for your graduation announcements, university ring, cap, gown and tassel information.
☐ Complete the Career Services Placement Survey
Career Services would like graduating seniors to provide employment information so that our college can have accurate statistics. You will receive this survey in the letter you are e-mailed during your semester of graduation. Its return is requested prior to rehearsal and if it is not received by then, you will be asked to complete it at rehearsal.



Attend the Senior Recognition Luncheon In our college, seniors are recognized the semester they graduate for their accomplishments. Graduating seniors will be invited via e-mail to the celebration that is usually held just prior to graduation rehearsal. Students graduating with Distinction and Latin Honors are also recognized at this luncheon.
Graduating seniors will receive an e-mail approximately the tenth week of the semester in which they intend to graduate with instructions including the date, time, and place of rehearsal practice. This information will also be posted here . Graduation rehearsal will typically be held the Friday before commencement every semester. You will be expected to stand with other students within our college. The rehearsal lasts about an hour and a half. You will not need to wear your cap and gown to the rehearsal at this time.
Attend the Commencement Ceremony Commencement ceremonies are typically held on a Sunday afternoon. No tickets are required and there is no limit on the number of guests attending. During the ceremony, which will last about two and a half hours, the president, the provost, and your cadet marshals will provide directions. Please listen carefully to their signals. Ohio State is one of the few institutions that distributes actual diplomas at commencement; therefore, we ask that students participate in the ceremony or notify us of your plan to not participate. Should you decide not to participate, you must notify the College Office, 100 Agricultural Administration, of your plan not to attend by the deadline set in your instructional e-mail. Participation in the ceremony is reserved for graduates only. The Ohio Stadium is the location for Commencement during Spring Semester only.
